Mack Truck, Volvo orders exceed 10,000

Greensboro-based Mack Trucks Inc. announced that orders for its Class 8 EPA 2010 trucks — when combined with the orders of its sister company Volvo Trucks North America — have exceeded the 10,000 mark.

The trucks are equipped with engines that feature the Mack ClearTech selective catalytic reduction system, which delivers near-zero emissions and is certified to EPA 2010 standards without the use of emissions credits.

“This milestone is in line with the fact that we were the first to achieve EPA 2010 certification, we had the trucks in customer hands early and often for testing, and we were ready to start production last fall,” said Kevin Flaherty, company senior vice president of sales and marketing, in a statement.

Mack Trucks Inc. is part of the Volvo Group, manufacturers of trucks, buses and construction equipment, drive systems for marine and industrial applications.
